

## **Other Conditions:**

- Transcripts and proofs must be submitted on Application day or within two days following application (no later than Friday at noon).
- Normal insurability to operate employer owned vehicles. Normal insurability is defined as the ability to secure insurance coverage without high-risk premium or cancellation.
- Drug testing will be required before placement.
- Candidates will be required to sign a Training Contract repayment plan.
- Short Resumes and/or work history will be accepted as well as letters of recommendation.



## **Minimum Requirements:**

- At Least 18 Years of Age
- High School Graduation or GED
- Official Transcript of High School Record or College Transcript showing proof of Algebra: One Full Year of High School Algebra with a C or better OR One Semester of College Algebra with a C or better
- Photo ID (Driver's License)
- Must be Physically Able to Perform Work of the Trade
- DMV printout/Driving History (online printout from DMV.ca.gov acceptable/suggested)
- DD-214 Required to Verify Military Training

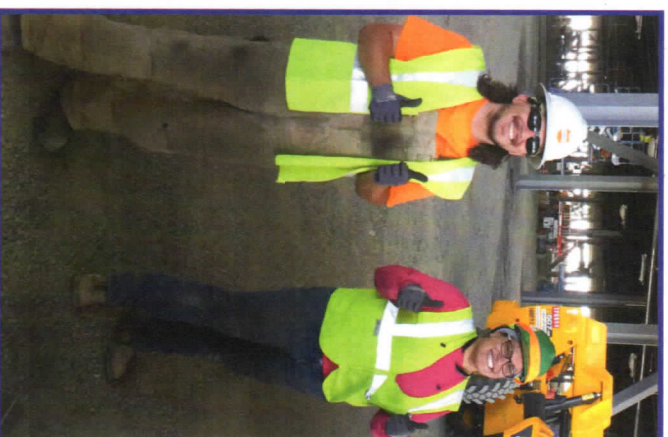
## **Qualifying Exams:**

- Applicants who meet the minimum requirements will be scheduled to take a WRITTEN TEST (notification will be sent by mail).

- Applicants who have a qualifying score on the written test will be scheduled for an ORAL INTERVIEW (notification will be sent by mail).

## **Characteristics of the Trade:**

Apprentices shall be under the supervision of a Journeyman Electrician. Physical effort required may involve climbing, crawling, crouching and working in cramped quarters. Wiring is frequently color coded for connection purposes. Mechanical ability and finger dexterity is essential. Work may be performed indoors or outdoors, below grade in ditches and trenches; or above grade on ladders or from scaffolding. Apprentice work assignments are generally limited to San Joaquin and Calaveras Counties. All apprentices are subject to drug testing.
