TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR EOPS STUDENTS MUST:

- Be eligible for the California Promise Grant, formerly Board of Governors Grant Fee Waiver (CCPG A or B) or (CCPG C with zero Estimated Family Contribution)
- 2. Be **enrolled** in 12 units (not wait listed)**
- 3. Meet **one** of the following educational criteria:
 - Assessment into basic skills English, ESL or Math
 - Not a high school graduate or GED recipient
 - Graduated from high school with less than a 2.5 GPA (submit unofficial transcript)
 - Previously enrolled in remedial education
 - Special Admission (by Director after eligible students admitted. Included first generation college students, ESL, recently emancipated Foster Youth).
- 4. Submit unofficial transcripts for all colleges/universities attended by the application deadline. **Students must submit official transcript(s) within 30 days of acceptance.**

EOPS serves eligible students until they have earned **70 degree applicable units**. Space is limited.
