TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR EOPS STUDENTS MUST:

1. Be eligible for the **California Promise Grant**, formerly Board of Governors Grant Fee Waiver (CCPG **A** or **B**) or (CCPG **C** with **zero** Estimated Family Contribution)
2. Be **enrolled** in 12 units (not wait listed)**
3. Meet **one** of the following educational criteria:
 - Assessment into basic skills English, ESL or Math
 - Not a high school graduate or GED recipient
 - Graduated from high school with less than a 2.5 GPA (submit unofficial transcript)
 - Previously enrolled in remedial education
 - Special Admission (by Director after eligible students admitted. Included **first generation college students, ESL, recently emancipated Foster Youth**).
4. Submit unofficial transcripts for all colleges/universities attended by the application deadline. **Students must submit official transcript(s) within 30 days of acceptance.**

*EOPS serves eligible students until they have earned **70 degree applicable units**. Space is limited.*

NOTE: Services are contingent upon budget availability and compliance with the Mutual Responsibility Contract

**EOPS/CARE grants based on student "unmet need" determined by Financial Aid Office*

***Unit exceptions may be available for DSPS participants on an individual basis*
