The Mexican [Frank] Sinatra, "The Idol of Mexico," and "The Rey of Ranchera Music" are a few of the aliases bestowed upon the man reverently known by his multi-generational legions of fans as "Chente": Vicente Fernandez. Born in the state of Jalisco, his early music career began as a singer for hire at 14 in restaurants and weddings in Tijuana before becoming a cultural icon of ranchera music, recording over 100 albums and contributing to over 30 films as singer, songwriter, actor, and producer in a half a century career. With his passing in 2021, world leaders and dignitaries praised him for his contributions to the arts, with Mexican President Andrés Manuel López Obrador recognizing Fernández as the "symbol of the ranchera song of our time..." and U.S President Joe Biden lamenting that "the world of music has lost an icon."
