### Tracy Unified Graduation Requirements

In high school you earn grades and credits for each class.

You must pass all classes with a grade of D or better.

• You must earn 220 credits in the required categories.

# How are credits earned in high school?

- Students earn credits each semester (2 semesters in a school year)
- Each semester is worth 30 credits /5 credits for each class (same 6 classes all year; August-May)
- 60 credits for each school year

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# **A-G Requirements**

Courses that students must complete (with a grade of C or better) to be minimally eligible for admission to the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU).

- A History 2 years
- B English 4 years
- C Math 3 years (4 years recommended)
- D Lab Science 2 years
- E Foreign Language 2 years
- F Visual & Performing Arts 1 year
- G College Prep Elective 1 year
- Must earn a C or better in all A-G courses

In order to begin the enrollment process at West High School the following paperwork and documentation is required and must be received by the counseling office:

#### Step 1

Complete the Online Enrollment found at https://www.tracy.kl2.ca.us, navigate to the Parent tab and click on "Aeries Online Enrollment". Follow the instructions found on that page to complete the enrollment process. <u>On the year selection page, please select 2021-2022</u>, Note: this can take 20-30 minutes to complete and can be done on any computer, laptop, tablet or smart phone. <u>Once completed, print and sign the Enrollment Confirmation and attach the required documents listed in Step 2, to this cover sheet.</u>

#### Step 2

Please attach and submit <u>COPIES</u> of the following items to this cover sheet. Originals cannot be returned.

- Signed Enrollment Confirmation (From Step 1)
- Birth Certificate (copies only please)
- Parent/Guardian Photo ID
- Immunization Records Physician stamped from doctor's office

#### Proof of Address

- Student Residency Questionnaire (Attached)
- Current Mortgage Statement/Rental Agreement or Property Tax Bill

#### Pick one of the following:

- Another Current Utility Bill (PG &E, City Water, Cable)
- DMV registration
- Proof of Residency from the San Joaquin County Registrar of Voters
- Other bill mailed to you at your address
- Foster Student Questionnaire (If Applicable)


